

Schedules Program

Federal Supply Schedules incorporate commercial buying practices, offering flexibility and a direct buying relationship with commercial partners. Under the Federal Supply Schedules program, GSA enters into contracts with commercial firms to provide products and services at established prices, terms, and conditions. *Once contracts are established, customers place their orders for delivery directly with the Schedules vendor.*

GSA*Advantage!*^{TIM} on-line shopping mall allows users to browse or search over a million products and services available through all FSS supply programs by:

GSA*Advantage!*TM facilitates best value decisions by enabling users to compare product features, prices, and delivery options on a single screen. After selecting supplies, customers can specify product configurations and accessories, select a payment method, and then place the order electronically.

Anyone can browse GSA*Advantage*^{ITM}, but only authorized users can place orders. An authorized user is one who has a GSA-assigned account number (Activity Address Code) and a password, Department of Defense Activity Address Code and password, or a Government purchase card. Federal customers can apply for an AAC and password on GSA*Advantage*^{ITM}.

Simplified Schedules Product Ordering Procedures

If the Schedules purchase is under the micropurchase threshold, you may place your order directly with the vendor for the item that best meets your needs.

If the Schedules purchase is over the micropurchase threshold you must make a Best Value determination, in accordance with FAR 8.404. To do this you can:

- Review the GSA*Advantage*. on-line electronic ordering system or review three Schedules vendor pricelists
- Select the best value
- Place order directly with contractor

When determining Best Value, you can consider:

- Special features
- Trade-in considerations
- Probable life of the product/service
- Warranty considerations
- Maintenance availability
- Past performance
- Environmental and energy efficiency considerations
- Other aspects important to your specific needs

Simplified Schedules Service Ordering Procedures

- 1. Prepare a request (Request for Quote or other communication tool) that includes:
 - A statement of work
 - A request for a firm-fixed price or a ceiling price if it is not possible at the time of placing the order to estimate accurately the extent or duration of the work
 - A description of the basis of selecting the contractor to receive the order
- 2. Transmit the request to three contractors if the proposed order is estimated to exceed the micropurchase threshold.
- 3. Evaluate responses and select the contractor that represents the best value based on the selection criteria stated in the request.

E-Buy

E-Buy is GSA's Internet-based electronic Requests for Quote (RFQ) solution designed to facilitate the request for and submission of quotes for a wide range of commercial services and products that are offered by GSA Federal Supply Schedule contractors who are on GSA*Advantage!*TM. This type of system is commonly referred to as a reverse auction.

E-Buy allows Federal agencies to maximize their buying power by leveraging the power of the Internet to streamline purchasing processes and increase competition, resulting in time and money savings to the Federal Government.

Using GSA's E-Buy system, agencies may prepare and post an RFQ for specific services and products for a designated period of time. Once posted, GSAAdvantage!TM Schedule contractors in the appropriate product or service category will receive an e-mail notice informing them that an RFQ has been posted and a quote is requested. Once the RFQ has closed, agencies may accept the quote(s) that represent the best value and then issue an order to any contractor whose quote was accepted.

FedBizOpps.gov - Fedbizopps.gov

GSA has teamed with the Department of Defense and NASA to develop and implement a Government-wide electronic posting system for Federal Government contract opportunities, called **Fedbizopps.gov**. Federal agencies can use **Fedbizopps.gov**, formerly known as the Electronic Posting System (EPS), to post pre-solicitation notices, solicitations, and other procurement information for product and service purchases in excess of \$25,000. The electronic format of **Fedbizopps.gov** allows for quicker posting and wider distribution of Government contract opportunities than traditional posting methods, resulting in time and money savings for the Federal Government. Eventually, agencies will be able to receive proposals electronically through **Fedbizopps.gov**.

TTOS (for USPS customers only)

FSS's Touchtone Telephone Ordering System (TTOS) allows United States Postal Service customers to place orders for GSA supply items via touchtone telephone. In addition to placing orders, USPS customers can use TTOS to cancel orders and receive fax confirmation of order transactions. TTOS requires minimal input from the user and does not require training in new technologies. If you can use a telephone, you can use TTOS.

To access TTOS, a customer will need a Personal Identification Number (PIN). FSS issues PIN's to authorized individuals upon the completion and approval of a GSA/FSS Supply Systems application. To obtain an application, contact the FSS National Customer Service Center (NCSC) at:

ELECTRONIC REQUISITIONING SYSTEMS

To accommodate the varying needs and resources of its customers, GSA accepts various forms of electronic supply requisitions.

FEDSTRIP/MILSTRIP

The Federal and Military Standard Requisitioning and Issue Procedures (FEDSTRIP/MILSTRIP) allow for automated processing of supply requisitions by the three principal supply sources for civilian and military agencies – GSA, the Department of Defense, and the Department of Veterans Affairs.

The key to using FEDSTRIP is your agency's Activity Address Code (AAC). Civilian agencies can apply for an AAC and password on GSA*Advantage!*TM (**www.gsaAdvantage.GOV**) or by writing to:

MUFFIN

The Multi-Use File for Interagency News (MUFFIN) is an electronic version of the FEDSTRIP requisitioning system that customers can use to order supplies via a personal computer and modem. This system offers standardized requisition entry and transmission advantages to requisitioning agencies.

Familiarity with the FEDSTRIP requisitioning system is necessary to use MUFFIN's requisition entry program. Before a customer can submit a requisition using MUFFIN, he/she must acquire a password for identification in the system. (This password requirement helps to prevent the submission of unauthorized requisitions.) MUFFIN passwords can be obtained by writing to:

ROCS

Retail On-Line Customer Sales (ROCS) allows customers to place orders to GSA's Supply Business via a personal computer and modem. To use ROCS, customers need their agency's Activity Address Code (AAC) and will need to contact their local Customer Supply Center to obtain a user code and password.

Military Interdepartmental Purchase Requests (MIPR)

GSA welcomes its Department of Defense customers to use Military Interdepartmental Purchase Requests (MIPR) to order supplies for special projects requiring multiple years to complete or for high dollar requirements. MIPR enable Department of Defense customers to obligate funds from the current fiscal year to purchase supplies for future delivery, even in subsequent years. MIPR should be submitted to the FSS Business Unit that is responsible for the requested commodities (see the FSS Business Unit chart on page 12 to determine the appropriate Business Unit). FSS will process the MIPR within 48 hours, deliver the products according to the timeframe specified by the customer, and track expenditures against the MIPR.



PURCHASING A VEHICLE

GSA consolidates agency requisitions at various intervals throughout the year, creating substantial purchase discounts.

Other benefits of purchasing through GSA are:

- Low prices
- Professional engineering services including technical assistance and vehicle design
- A wide variety of vehicle types
- Established multi-year, multi-vendor contracts providing a choice of vehicle models
- Informative web site featuring an on-line AutoChoice program which allows you to choose and configure vehicle makes and models, place an order on-line, obtain order status updates
- Express Desk
- Choice of delivery to a nearby dealer or direct to your location
- Disposal opportunity through GSA vehicle auctions

An additional GSA buying service is the Express Desk, (703) 308-4576. This service is available to expedite urgent and compelling vehicle requirements in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 6. Under this program, GSA's Automotive Division will acquire vehicles from dealers typically within 5-10 days. Prices are higher than contract, but GSA negotiates the best available price. This service is offered at a 5% surcharge.

LEASING A VEHICLE

GSA Fleet is a full-service professional fleet management organization with rates that are second to none. Fleet manages over 168,000 vehicles making it one of the largest non-tactical fleets in the world.

Benefits include:

- Low national lease rates set annually for easy budgeting.
- All vehicles are leased on a cost reimbursable basis charging a flat monthly rate and mileage fee that covers all costs including the vehicle, maintenance, fuel, accident management and even car washes.
- Provides alternative fuel vehicle options.
- "Mileage Express" on-line mileage reporting.
- "Reports Carryout" on-line Fleet vehicle inventories.

GSA leases vehicles for long-term use. For short-term vehicle rental (less than 30 days) see the "Travel and Transportation" section of this guide.

GSA REPAIR SERVICE AND VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

GSA maintains a national Maintenance Control Center (MCC) with toll free phone access. The goal of the MCC's is to maximize the serviceable life of GSA Fleet Vehicles by prompting service when needed. MCC employees are trained automotive service technicians who retain computerized vehicle records and determine the most economical and convenient source for repairs or service.



Personal Property Management

In its role as an asset manager for Federal personal property, FSS arranges for redistribution of excess property among Federal agencies, donations of excess property to eligible State and local governments and public nonprofit groups, and sale of surplus property to the public. The FSS Personal Property Management Office will locate and dispose of excess property for customer agencies through three programs.

What We Have

UTILIZATION PROGRAM

Encourages other Federal agencies to reuse your agency's unneeded personal property. You declare the property "excess" and refer it to FSS for Government-wide screening. FSS makes it available for transfer to other Federal agencies or to their contractors, cooperatives, or project grantees.

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DONATION PROGRAM

The donation program enables certain non-Federal organizations to obtain personal property the Federal Government no longer needs. Through State Agencies for Surplus Property (SASP), property can be obtained by non-Federal public agencies and private non-profit organizations and institutions (such as educational, health, elderly and homeless programs).

SALES PROGRAM

Gives individuals and businesses an opportunity to buy unneeded Federal Government property.

GSA sells personal property for civilian Federal agencies via sealed bid, fixed price, auction, spot bid, or negotiated sales. Sale proceeds are returned to the Federal treasury or, when authorized, to generating agency accounts. [The Department of Defense (DoD) handles sales for the military services.]

How To Get What We Have

Federal Property Managers are encouraged to contact their Regional Property Management Office whenever they have or need excess property. In addition, the Federal Disposal System (FEDS) is available to learn instantly of available excess property and to report property excess.

WEB

Federal Disposal System (FEDS) - fss.gsa.gov/property/feds

The FEDS system, available at the above web address, is a tracking and allocation system for Federal excess, surplus and exchange/sale property reported to GSA. It is a real-time system with on-line and modem access. FEDS is used to report excess, screen for excess and compete for it. Agencies may search GSA's inventory through a process known as screening, and they may select property for transfer by freezing specific items. FEDS also creates the appropriate documents required to complete the property transfer.

FEDS is available to three groups of users:

- Federal agencies
- Authorized non-Federal recipients
- State Agencies for Surplus Property (SASP)

Also available at the FEDS site is the Agency Asset Management System (AAMS), currently in use by The Department of Commerce (DOC) and The Department of Energy (DOE) to report, freeze, and transfer excess personal property exclusively within their agency. At the end of the internal screening any property remaining is either returned or passed on to FEDS for other agencies to compete. Please contact the Property Management Central Office if your agency would like more information about AAMS.



To utilize FEDS you need a log-on code. Contact your agency's National Utilization Officer (NUO) or call the Property Management Division at (703) 305-7240 to become an authorized user. The RPMO is your main contact for excess disposal or acquisition. Agencies can request regional mailings of excess catalogs and bulletins. For those without Internet access, requests can also be submitted by telephone, letter, or electronic message or by GSA Form 1539 or excess reported on SF 120. Agencies can also be placed on a "want list" which is usually screened for a period of 180 days for local or national inventories.

The RPMO will arrange for property inspection and help you complete property transfer and the transfer order (Standard Form 122). The RPMO also handles requests for accelerated property disposal.

FEDS (Modem connection) 1-888-377-2122

If you do not have Internet access, you can access FEDS by a modem dialup. This requires communication software with VT100 emulation and a log-on code. Contact your agency's National Utilization Officer or call the Property Management Division at (703) 305-7240 to become an authorized user. 




GSA SmartPay Travel Card

The GSA SmartPay Travel Card program provides Federal agencies with a valuable and efficient payment tool for airline tickets, lodging, restaurant expenses, car rentals, taxis and all of your other travel-related expenses.

Air Fare Programs

GSA has developed an extremely successful Airline City Pair Program. This service originally covered only 11 markets, but over the last 20 years, it has expanded to almost 5,000 city pairs. The airfares offered under this program average a 70% discount off comparable commercial fares; saving the Federal Government approximately \$2 billion annually. In addition to the tremendous price savings, the Airline City Pair Program has many features that allow Government travelers all the flexibility possible in planning official travel. The benefits include:

Car Rental Programs

For Government employees traveling on official business, rental car companies offer special rates negotiated by the Military Traffic Management Command (MTMC). The MTMC agreement includes full comprehensive and collision coverage as well as unlimited mileage programs.

GSA Value Lodging



DLA also redistributed many of the FSCs it managed internally, from one of its supply centers to another.
